Problem (2)

2 points Problem is stated with enough information so that someone who has not seen the problem would know what the POW was all about.

1 point Problem is partially stated. Not enough facts given.

Strategy (4)

4 points Explanation of how you solved the problem is clear. All mathematical computations are indicated. Any tables or diagrams are indicated. You described what you did and why.

3 points Explanation of what you did to solve the problem is good, but you do not include some of the mathematics, charts and/or thought processes.

2 points Explanation is weak. The strategy you used to solve the problem may be incomplete. Work is not shown.

1 point Some work is shown, but no reason why you are doing it, is given. Strategy may be incorrect.

Solution (2)

2 points The solution is correct and all parts of the solution are included. Your reasons why you believe the solution to be correct are stated.

1 point Answer is partially correct

0 points Solution may be correct, but you showed little to no evidence in your strategy of how you got your answer. Solution is not correct
